In January 2010, a divine call resonated after a 21-day fast, proclaiming, "The Time for Africa is now" This marked the inception of the Apostolic Leaders Conference (ALC), a sacred institution founded by the visionary Archbishop Hezekiah.

ALC emerged as a beacon of faith, dedicated to Evangelism, Missions, Prayer, and Community works. Crossing boundaries of ethnicity and geography, it swiftly spread its wings across Nigeria, Benin Republic, Togo, Cameroon and Ghana. Today, this divine mission has flourished into a formidable presence, spanning 20 states in Nigeria, with over 31 Zones/Chapters in Nigeria and 20 more zones/chapters in Ghana, Togo, and Benin of Republic and Cameroon.

Recognizing the growing involvement of churches, pastors, bishops, and apostles, Archbishop Hezekiah led the expansion, culminating in the formation of Christ-Fellowship of Churches (CFC), merging spiritual and communal endeavors. ALC transformed into ALC-CFC, providing spiritual covering, mentoring, and fostering growth for leaders and believers.

Spearheading evangelism, missions, and community outreach, ALC-CFC has become a force for positive change. In response to her vast growth, a Governing Board was instituted, featuring a Joint College of Bishops and Apostles handling spiritual matters and Canonical

Administrators overseeing administration, operations, and logistics.

Archbishop Hezekiah's visionary leadership continues to guide ALC-CFC, creating an enduring legacy that transcends borders and enriches lives. Committed to Global Missions, we carry forward the spirit of faith and unity instilled by Archbishop Hezekiah.

Looking into the Future

ALC-CFC is a platform in the hands of our Lord and Savior for His end time use. This organization is now a regional branch of the Global Apostolic Leaders Network (GALN), GALN is in 4 Continents of the World (Europe, North-America, Africa and Asia), represented in 35 countries. 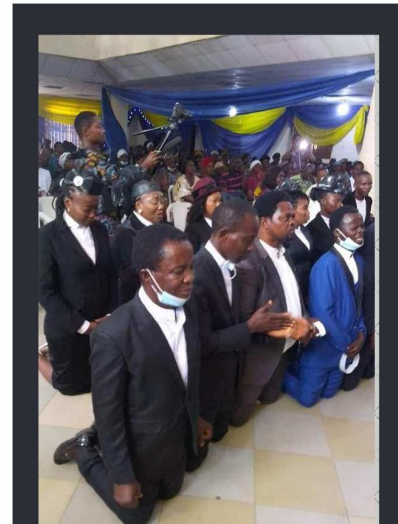
Driving Growth Through Service and Fellowship:

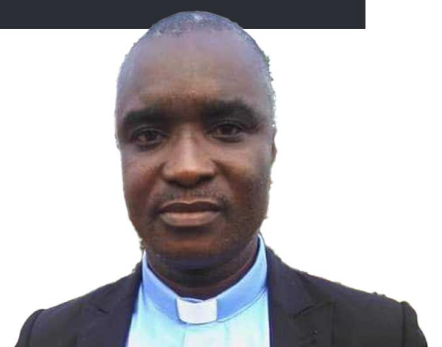

ALC-CFC National Leader speaks

ALC is an interdenominational organization that provides an enabling platform for the ministers from the five-fold ministries across churches in order to fellowship and network together and to also nurture individual callings and gifts into maturity. It is an apostolic organization creating ministers fellowships and networks, engaging in conferences and seminars, community evangelism, mission, medical outreach, prayers, community service and leadership development and influence in all strata of life and endeavors.

ALC was officially inaugurated in Nigeria in July 2011 by the visionary leader, the Archbishop, Most Rev. Dr. Hezekiah Adenekan Adesanya in the year 2011. I joined the network as a member from its inception in 2011. My first official responsibility was to serve as the assistant zonal leader that same year and by the grace of God, I have risen through the ranks and files of the organization. My primary motivation for joining ALC-CFC is the well articulated vision of the organization, explained in an unambiguous manner. To me, that was the selling point.

On the advent of ALC-CFC, its first major meeting bothered on crusade, free medical outreach and Ministers' conference at Festac Town in Lagos. Other free medical programs were held in Alimosho Local Government Area. Boreholes were sunk at Alimoso, Orile-Iganmu and other needy communities after surveys showed that people in the areas were experiencing acute water shortage. Our organization has helped to put many children in schools from nursery schools to

the tertiary institutions, ALC-CFC has provided scholarships to help salvage pupils and students in the time of dire need. A church under the Ikorodu zone of ALC was rebuilt after the old facility was destroyed by storms. We organize zonal, national and international conferences, seminars, ordination of Ministers and consecration of Bishops and Apostles, welfare programs to assist members, farming activities, educational institutions such as REMWO Institute of Theology (RIT). These among others are our landmark impacts that have endeared the network to the hearts of many around the globe.

ALC- CFC is a forum creating opportunities for growth and personal development which impacts in significant measures, lives, families, businesses and ministries of all the members. Iron sharpens iron, and one man sharpens another (Proverbs 27:17). That's what the organization is all about. We have all been touched in many ways, so numerous to mention, and we give God the glory.



Obeying The Great Commission in Matthew 28:18-20 of Jesus' instruction to his disciples to make disciples of all nations, baptizing and teach them to observe all things that Jesus has taught them, this is the primary driving force of the fellowship. We evangelize, we do missions, there's strong

fellowship among members, the reason why we are still here and relevant to the communities, churches and the nations at large after 13 years of its establishment. We just obey the Master.

I have been the National Leader since the year 2013, I must say that to lead people is a great task, but leading leaders comes with higher responsibilities and tact. I have had to provide guidance, coordination, direction, and motivation to the zonal leaders, state leaders as well to the national executives. The Archbishop has always been forthright in providing the needed support and leadership at all times. Today, we are in 20 states of the Federation with several zones spanning across the nation. We are currently present in Ghana, Togo, Republic du Benin, Cameroon, Niger. ALC-CFC has grown in leaps and bounds, to God be the glory.

ALC-CFC has lived up to its vision. Our impacts in the communities where our member churches are represented speak for itself. Free medical programs,

scholarship, community boreholes, construction of local waste disposal facilities, etc. Through these, we have always gained the support, the collaboration and the goodwill of the people we serve.

FRANCOPHONE THRUST

Since our inception in 2022 in the Republic of Togo, Apostolic Leadership Conference (ALC-CFC) has been steadfast in her mission to bring hope and transformation to communities across the region. Led by Apostle Olatunji Onilude and with the invaluable support of Elder Clement, we have been privileged to witness the impact of our initiatives centered on evangelism, discipleship, and community development.

Our journey began in the town of Kpalime, where we identified the urgent needs of the community of Glive in the northern part of Togo. Faced with challenges such as lack of government infrastructure, education, clean water, sanitation, and electricity, the residents were in desperate need of assistance. In response, we launched a mission outreach program and constructed a latrine, aiming to improve hygiene and combat the spread of diseases, thus laying the foundation for a healthier and more sustainable future for Glive.

In 2023, we revisited Togo with renewed determination, expanding our reach to three different towns. In Kpalime, we organized a two-day leadership conference, equipping individuals with the skills and knowledge necessary to lead effectively within their communities. Meanwhile, in Agbomeyor, we conducted a free medical mission and evangelical outreach, providing essential healthcare services and spreading the message of faith and hope. Additionally, we inaugurated a new chapter of ALC in Anie, further extending our reach and impact across Togo.



At the core of our mission lies evangelism, discipleship, and community transformation. By prioritizing these principles, we continue to make a profound difference in the lives of individuals and communities throughout Togo. As we look ahead to the future, we remain committed to reaching even more people with the transformative power of the gospel, fostering spiritual growth, and empowering communities to thrive.

As entrepreneurs and community advocates, she and her husband champion initiatives, from feeding and agricultural programs to youth employment, educational scholarships, and free medical programs — each embodying Christian values that uplift communities.
